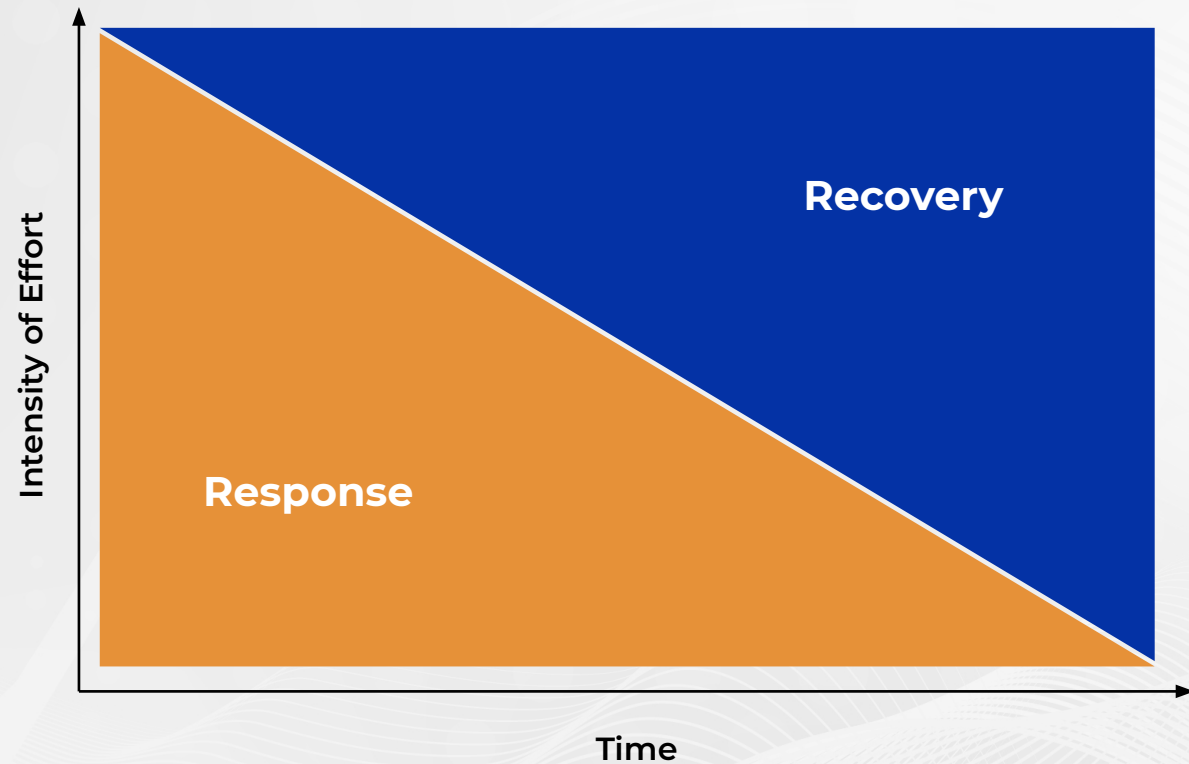

Recovery Considerations

- Leadership must be allocated early
- Resource needs including personnel, materials, specialist technical expertise
- Cost tracking & recovery
- Investigations & assurance
- Tempo of activities for a prolonged recovery

Considerations:

- Response activities complete - use the priorities / objectives list
- Personnel accounted for & support activities initiated
- Business continuity activities - continue or stand-down?
- Recovery - objectives set & leader identified
- Stakeholder management - communications plan in place
- Investigations - site secured, investigation details established
- Cost capture - method for capturing financial impacts / costs related to response and recovery activities (may be required to continue past CMT stand down)
